


Dead blow hammer

Product features


- metal balls in the head absorb the impact
- those granulate absorb the impact
- lacquered metal housing
- lacquered metal tubular handle with plastic grip
- polyurethane faces are unchangeable
- high security


Advantages:

- Advantage over an ordinary hammer is that it doesn't bounce back from the object because of the steel granulate which absorb the impact.
- Steel balls in the hammer head prevents rebound and adds additional striking force.
- Less handle vibration while striking!

Usage:

- Hammer is used for mounting ball bearings, for furniture assembly, interior and exterior lay paving.
- Not recommended for use on sharp objects. Strike on sharp objects can damage polyurethane face of the hammer.
